ORDER

On January 31, 2019, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. (Columbia Kentucky), filed

its proposed Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) application to be effective March 1, 2019. Due

to delays caused by extreme weather conditions on January 30, 2019, Columbia

Kentucky was unable to file its GCA application with 30 days' notice as set forth in its

tariff. Columbia Kentucky requests that the Commission permit the rates to go into effect

for March 1, 2019, pursuant to KRS 278.180, which permits the Commission to approve

a notice period of less than thirty days but not less than 20 days. After reviewing the

record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Columbia Kentucky's application includes revised rates designed to pass

on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.

2. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out an Expected Gas Cost of \$4.2133

per Mcf.

3. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out a rate for Banking and Balancing

Service of \$.0216 per Mcf.

4. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out no supplier Refund Adjustment.

- 5. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out a current quarter Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) of \$.5283 per Mcf and a total ACA of (\$.2450) per Mcf.
- 6. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out a Balancing Adjustment of (\$.0500) per Mcf.
- 7. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out no Special Agency Service refund adjustment.
- 8. Columbia Kentucky's application sets out a Performance-Based Rate Adjustment of \$.3479 per Mcf.
- 9. Columbia Kentucky's GCA is \$4.2662 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.5759 per Mcf from the previous GCA of \$4.8421 per Mcf.
- 10. The rates as proposed by Columbia Kentucky and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for billing beginning on March 1, 2019.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates proposed by Columbia Kentucky and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for billing beginning on March 1, 2019. Although Columbia Kentucky's GCA application did not provide 30 days' notice to the Commission as required by its tariff, KRS 278.180(2) authorizes the Commission to make a reduction in rates effective in less than 30 days.
- 2. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Columbia Kentucky shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.

3.	This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
