- 4. Provide the analysis of the dollar value to the utility of the amount of water loss in excess of 15 percent, based upon the water loss numbers contained in the 2018 annual report.

For each transaction labeled as a Miscellaneous Transfer, provide an explanation detailing the exact dollar amount of the transaction, the purpose of the transfer, and why it was necessary.
