ORDER

On March 5, 2019, Southern Water and Sewer District (Southern District) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission notes that in its 2018 Annual Report, Southern District reported a water loss of 62.5171 percent.² Southern District's application provides updated purchase and sales information for a more current period than the 2018 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066(6)(3) states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2018 Annual Report.³ Southern District's unaccounted-for water loss is determined to be 62.5184 percent for the period. The Commission notes the information in the 2018 Annual Report is for the same reporting period and that the slight difference in percentage

unaccounted-for water loss is due to rounding.⁴ Reduction of Southern District's unaccounted-for water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate \$648,951.61⁵ decrease to production and purchased water expense. Potentially, Southern District is paying approximately \$2.4500 per 1,000 gallons sold, for expenses associated with unaccounted-for water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent threshold.⁶

As a result of Southern District's continued failure to address its excessive water loss the Commission has made Southern District a party to an open case at the Commission for utilities with unacceptably high unaccounted-for water loss.⁷

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Southern District purchases water from the city of Pikeville (Pikeville), the Prestonsburg City Utility Commission (PCUC), and the Knott County Water District (Knott County District).

2. Pikeville notified Southern District that its wholesale volumetric water rate would increase from \$1.72 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.25 effective October 16, 2018.⁸ Southern District proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective March 1, 2019, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Pikeville.

3. Southern District proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.30 per 1,000 gallons in its application.

4. During the 12 months ended December 30, 2018, Southern District purchased 149,536,000 gallons of water from Pikeville, 21,484,800 gallons of water from PCUC, and 18,198,900 gallons of water from Knott County District and produced 568,330,000 gallons of water. During the same period, Southern District sold 264,590,000 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$79,254.08, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.30 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.30 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved.

6. Southern District's proposed rates should be approved.

7. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for water service rendered by Southern District on and after March 1, 2019.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.30 per 1,000 gallons is approved.


2. The rates proposed by Southern District are approved.

3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Southern District on and after March 1, 2019.

4. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Southern District shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.

5. This case is hereby closed and will be removed from the Commission's docket.
