# Resident concerned over proposed cellphone tower

## Lebanon man feels the proximity of a proposed Bluegrass Cellular cellphone tower is too close to his home

Cecil Peers, 70, is a resident of Lebanon who is content to living out his retirement enjoying his grandchildren, family and tending to his chickens and garden. However, he feels his quality of life could be disturbed with the possible addition of a cellphone

tower just yards from his home.

Peers said approximately three months ago, he walked outside of his home to see developers checking out the property beside his home, which is owned by Storage on 208, LLC. The location of the tower is estimated to be less than 300 feet from Peers' residence, according to Peers.

"I didn't know anything about it

when it started," said Peers. "They came out with their equipment and pulled down my right of way. I went outside thinking 'what on earth?' I went outside and questioned them, and they told me they were putting a cellphone tower on the property beside my home."

Peers said he soon received a letter in the mail on behalf of Bluegrass Cellular and Kentucky

RSA #4 Cellular General Partnership. The letter explained the site was being considered for the placement of a cellphone tower, and he could send a letter to voice any concerns or ask questions.

"I called these people, but I didn't really get a satisfactory
