### ORDER

By Order entered July 5, 2019, the Commission initiated a formal investigation into damage on August 23, 2018, to an underground natural gas pipeline located in Covington, Kentucky. Said damage was the result of excavation activities by an employee of the City of Covington. The City of Covington filed a response to the Order on July 25, 2019.

Based on an in-depth review of Covington's response, which sets forth the details of Covington's excavation activities on August 23, 2018, the Commission finds that Covington's activities were not unreasonable under the circumstances. Consequently, the hearing scheduled for August 9, 2019, should be cancelled and this investigation should be closed.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The hearing scheduled in this matter for August 9, 2019, is cancelled.
- 2. The Commission's investigation of the August 23, 2018 excavation damage incident is closed.
  - 3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
