# MOTION TO AMEND EXHIBITS OF BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 4(5) and 5, Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission for permission to amend Exhibits Smith-1, Smith-4, and Smith-5, which were attached to the Direct Testimony of Paul G. Smith filed July 31, 2019 in the above-captioned proceeding ("Testimony"). Since the time the Testimony was filed, the portion of Station Two decommissioning costs owed by the City of Henderson, Kentucky and City of Henderson Utility Commission (collectively, "Henderson") to Big Rivers has increased substantially. Specifically, the total amount of decommissioning costs due to Big Rivers has grown from \$134,098 as of June 30, 2019 to \$716,458 as of December 31, 2019. This has been slightly offset by an increase in the amount of operating costs owed by Big Rivers to Henderson, which has grown from \$798,261 as of June 30, 2019 to \$941,581 as of December 31, 2019. Taking both of these changes into account, the total amount that is immediately owed to Big Rivers pursuant to the terms of its Contracts with Henderson has risen from the \$718,942 reflected in the July 31, 2019 version of Exhibit Smith-1 to \$1,157,982.

Accordingly, given the material increase in costs owed to Big Rivers by Henderson pursuant to the Contracts and in the interests of a complete record upon which the Commission may base its ultimate decision in this case, Big Rivers respectfully requests that the Commission permit Amended Exhibits Smith-1, Smith-4, and Smith-5 (included as attachments to this Motion) to be part of the record in this proceeding.
