Proposed rate increase for Water service in Bell County Ky:

Request to *delay* Utilities INC increase in Bell County Ky by 30 days from the date of the **SECOND** notice based on **MISINFORMATION!!!**

I just received a notice from Utilities INC that read:

CORRECTION OF PRIOR NOTICE OF PROPOSED INCREASE:

Water services corp of KY INADVERTENTLY issued a notice on June 1st, 2020 to customers in the **MIDDLESBORO** service area informing them that the company intends to adopt a rate increase for customers in its **CLINTON** service area.

I am confident that you didn't receive any rebuttal's from Middlesboro customers since this notice DID NOT apply!

The "second" notice (which was our 1st notice) came out as a "correction" and is now giving us a 7 day window to submit a written request to intervene with the decision of the public service commissions decision rather than the initial 30 days that was given to customers in the **CLINTON** service area.

I would like to draft a petition to be signed by Middlesboro customers outlining the reasons Bell Co, (*along with the other 9 LOWEST POVERTY LEVEL counties in our state*) should be exempt from this increase.

Bell Co Ky is at a 38% poverty rate which is well more than DOUBLE the 14.6% National poverty rate.

Your attention to the matter is greatly appreciated.
