To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing to you as a lifelong Kentuckian with a degree in environmental engineering and a growing concern that the PSC is placing utility profits above all other considerations when setting rates. Here are my concerns.

First, doing away with net-metering has a damaging impact on the Commonwealth and the broader world. But allowing the kind of punitive pricing sought in this case should be unthinkable. I implore you to require actual data on the costs and the benefit of household photo-voltaic arrays (home solar). I am confident that any valid analysis would show the cost structure sought in this case is highly inappropriate.

Second, increases in flat/minimum fees is a highly regressive means of bolstering the bottom line for utilities - especially in light of the pandemic and its resultant economic downturn.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. Please take a hard look at this rate request and than do what is right and fair.

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
