To Whom it May Concern,

I am writing you to offer my enthusiastic support of the Unbridled Solar Project, a Geronimo Energy solar energy development partially located in 4 Star Industrial Park, which straddles the Henderson County and Webster County lines.

The Unbridled Solar Project will benefit our counties in multiple ways:

- 1) It will enhance our ability to bring new jobs to our region by offering a significant renewable source of energy to manufacturers for whom that is a prerequisite. The demand for renewables as part of a company's energy mix is a growing trend and we must be ready to meet that need.
