This letter is in response to the certified letter that was delivered to inform us that an AT & T guyed cell tower will be located on State Route 2194 W, Hickory, Kentucky. I have read the sign that was put on property adjacent to our farm located on 2194 and on other property we own located behind where the tower is to be erected. I do not understand why another cell tower is needed in this area as one is on property not a mile from the proposed cell tower.

This is a residential area where we have rental property and this area does not need to be blighted with two cell towers. Why was it proposed to be placed in such a populated area? In observing other cell towers in the county, they seem to be located on a higher ground rather than on a low bottom ground. I do hope the planners who decided to erect the tower on this sight are aware that this is a flood zone. It is my objection to the tower being erected in a beautiful neighborhood where the people who have lovely homes and who travel this road daily will have to see such an ugly communication tower. We are also concerned about the health problems that could be caused from the radioactivity given off from the cell towers. Not only could this be a factor in destroying crops as well as animals in the area living close to the towers. This information is documented on cell tower dangers on the computer.


