I am writing to the commission in regard to a letter that I received informing families in Scott County of Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company's proposal to purchase our community's sewer systems from Delaplain Disposal. (Case #: 2020-00290) In the letter Bluegrass Water proposes a rate increase of 669.1% for the area in which I reside that is listed in their Rate Comparison Table as the I-75 & Delaplain interchange area of Scott County. This would increase our monthly sewer bill significantly from \$12.50 to \$96.14 per month. My area of Scott County is just one of the areas within our community that Bluegrass Water has proposed large rate increases. There will be many families negatively impacted by these rates if the commission approves this proposal and that is why I am writing to ask you to deny their request to impose these unfair and inflated prices. As a family who owns a small business, we have been dealt some financial blows this year and a large increase in our utilities like this would only add to the financial strain that so many families like mine find ourselves in. I have a family of four in my home and our water bill typically costs about \$40 to \$50 per month. The idea of paying twice as much for sewer as we pay for water seems highly unreasonable to me and I know many other families will feel the same way. I ask that you take the feelings of these families and mine into consideration when you are making your decision on this matter.
