Dear Public Service Commission

I have received a proposed rate increase from Peoples Gas KY LLC.

First: I would address the "the offset of \$3.83 for the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act Surcredit." To receive the credit you have to file a Federal Income tax return. For some of us that are disabled and do not file a return there will be no offset. Not as good as it sounds on paper.

Second: the Customer Charge is at \$7.50. An increase to \$21.00 is a 180% increase not the the 59% increase that is on the notice. A 59% increases would only be to \$11.92

Thirdly: the Base Rate is at \$2.1322 per Mcf. An increase to \$4.3185 is a increase of 102.5% not the 59% shown in the Proposed Rate increase notice. A 59% increase would only be \$3.3901

Four: For us Peoples Gas is a gas delivery company, they buy the gas from Equable Gas, and never touch it. As you can see in the attached bills the Commodity rate can increase or even double in some months. Putting a strain on fixed income-households.

We ask you the Public Service Commission in considering the people who are on fixed incomes in the Eastern Kentucky areas. We know that there will be increases at times, but such an increase all at once is uncalled for. We notice in the Proposed Rate Increase notice that the whole reason for the increase is the transfer of ownership of People Gas KY LLC. To Delta Natural Gas Company. Just because it depends on a transfer of ownership is not a significant reason for an increase. This matter is totally in your hands, and we ask you to consider the matter with all sincerely. 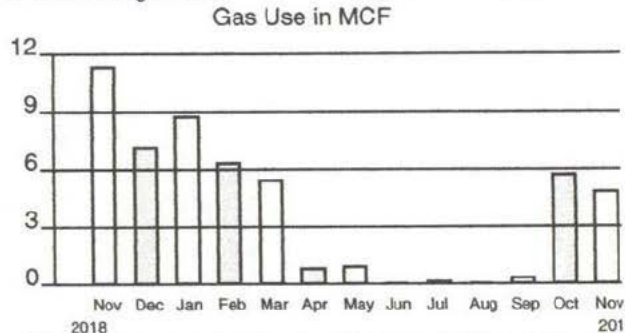

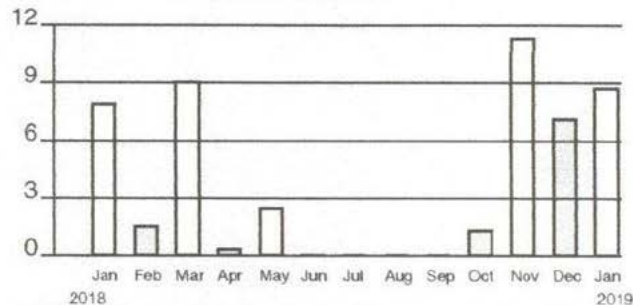

This letter is to file an objection to the aforementioned

1. The rate change nearly TRIPLES the current rate. This is exorbitant and unreasonable!
2. In my case, my gas meter comes directly off the well and is, in fact, the first to do so.
3. There should be no expense connected to my service other than making out the bills for us to pay.
4. Up until Peoples gas bought out Equitable Gas there was no service charge. A lot of the time I didn't have to pay any bill whatsoever because of how little I had used.
5. The \$7.50 Customer Charge is now being asked to increase to \$21.00 per month. This increase is Highway Robbery. My income is \$ 1,089.94 per month from Railroad Retirement. I am 80 years old. With this Covid 19 virus going around, the Gas company should be trying to lower their rates—not triple them.


6. Peoples gas is also asking that their Base Rate be increased from \$ 2.1322 to \$ 4.3185, which is more than Double the Current rate.



In response to your letter advising that Peoples Gas KY intends to change the rate of providing natural gas as well as transferring ownership to Delta National Gas Company, it seems almost futile to object to the rate change. But, we can only try and be heard.

In the notice it was stated that the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the rates in this notice. It would be to our advantage to know what would cause the PSC to order rates that would not be as high as the proposed rates and the estimated 59% increase in our monthly billing. Surely the regulations passed by our previous legislatures have not placed such a huge burden on the gas company that we in turn must bear the brunt of it.

Most homes in this country are on a fixed income, whether the homeowners are still employed outside the home or have come to the place in their lives where they have become unable to work outside the home or have reached retirement. A 59% increase in the monthly billings to all these homes will certainly cause adjustments in their budgets and it will most likely present hardships in most of these homes. We do hope the PSC will take this into consideration and not grant such a large increase in the rates.

We understand and appreciate the challenges in operating a company as our household represents a small business. We realize our expenses and problems do not measure up to a company as large as Peoples Gas; however, we believe a 59% increase for the gas company "sweetens the pot" in the transfer of ownership. This should not come into play in the transfer and should not be passed on to the consumer.

- (1) A rate increase for customer service charge, from current rate of \$7.50 to \$21.00. This is nearly triple the current charge. Which is completely outrageous, considering that the only service provided is the bi-monthly reading of my gas meter.
