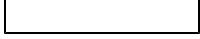
To Whom It Concerns,

I am writing regarding Kentucky Utilities proposed rate increase of 10.4%. I am a homeowner and landlord in Central Kentucky. I own and manage 170 units in the area. My tenants are primarily low income households. Most are responsible for their own utility bills.

A 10% rate increase would be unreasonable during good economic times. I have enough awareness of my customer's current situation that I have not raised rents on my tenants nor charged any late fees in 9 months. Further, I have no plans to do so in the coming months. It is troubling that a utility company would look to raise rates even 0.1% during a pandemic and economic crisis.

I ask you to consider the implication of any rate increase to the poorest members of our community while reviewing this proposal and reject it.
