I'm writing to the Commission concerning Kentucky Utilities Company's (KU) request for a 10.4% revenue increase, which would result in an increase in all residents electric bills of nearly \$13. per month.

It seems to me that KU has submitted similar rate increase requests every year lately and this request of 10.4% per month (or 68+ million dollars a year) is going over board. Especially when they give no charges they plan to make to justify the increase.

No one in the current economy receives a 10.4% annual increase in Income, especially those of us on a fixed income. And they try to soften the blow by proposing an Economic Relief Surcredit of .76¢ per month (the first year)!!

Plus they also plan to eliminate certain Environmental Cost Recovery Projects causing our base rates to increase as well.
