Sir/Madame

I am writing you concerning Louisville Gas and Electric proposed increase in electric and gas rates and charges effective January 1, 2021. Case No. 2020-00350.

They propose an 11.8% increase in residential electric rates and a 9.37% increase in residential gas rates. For a customer with an average monthly consumption, this works out to a yearly increase of \$140.88 in their electric bill and a \$74.04 in their gas bill, for a total of \$214.92.

Given the present 12 month inflation rate for all items is 1.2%, in my opinion, this increase seems very excessive.

The cost of living increase for social security for 2021 is 1.3%. For anyone relying on social security as their main source of income, this increase in their energy bill will be a significant burden.


Also with the present COVID-19 virus epidemic, thousands of people are unemployed and suffering financially. This is not the time to place this further burden upon them.
