B & H Gas Company of PO Box 447. Betsy Layne, KY 41605 ([REDACTED]) has sent notice per their customer billing information that they have requested nearly a 400% increase in the minimum monthly bill, and an approx. 300% increase in the average monthly bill. B & H Gas Co. further state that this increase will take effect in May 2021. I AM CONTESTING this proposal as an outrageous and

unaffordable tariff/rate increase. This will, in effect, render B & H Gas Co. services and provisions unaffordable. This enormous rate increase will financially cripple many consumers in an already very difficult economy. B & H Gas is the only natural gas provider in my area. They are a monopoly in my district, and if this rate increase goes in to effect I would be forced to pursue other affordable home heating systems/methods. I am requesting that KY PSC fully investigate this proposal by B & H Gas before any rate increase approval is granted.
