I am writing in response to docket number 2020-00365. I am a home and landowner who lives directly adjacent to the proposed site of this tower. I strongly oppose this cell tower and I am currently hiring counsel who will be representing me in the pursuit of stopping said tower from being erected. I bought my new home just over 1 year ago and the proposed 342-foot-tall tower, which will be roughly 60 yards from my front door, stands to seriously depreciate my home and land value- up to 20% in most cases. The entire west side of my home is built for this view that the massive tower will block. The west wall of my great room is entirely windows and sliding glass doors. This tower will be an eyesore, seen from every view of my living room and most of my home's bedrooms, as well as both of my outdoor seating areas. This tower will be something every eye is drawn to as it will stand at least 3 times higher than the current horizon line. The amount of light pollution from the tower will ruin every view at night as well as come in all of our windows and glass doors. I am also the owner and lead singer of the Billboard number 1 Christian rock band- 7eventh Time Down. My band records our music in my home studio with very sensitive microphones. The noise and radio frequency from the tower will destroy my only source of income, and with the added financial stress due to Covid-19 I cannot allow this to happen. Furthermore, over 60 self-supporting towers have fallen in the United States alone since 1955. My childrens' bedrooms will be roughly 50 yards from the base of this tower. This is a safety hazard I am not prepared to allow to go unchecked.
