<u>ORDER</u>

On January 23, 2020, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (LG&E/KU) filed an application requesting Commission approval of renewable power agreements (RPA), with a decision no later than March 31, 2020. The Commission finds that a procedural schedule should be established for the timely processing of this proceeding. The attached procedural schedule establishes deadlines for motion to intervene and for the first round of discovery. Subsequent procedural events will be scheduled at the conclusion of a formal conference to be held on February 6, 2020.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed in this proceeding.

2. a. Responses to requests for information in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable and shall be appropriately bookmarked. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to

questions related to the information provided, with an original in paper medium and an electronic version to the Commission.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information that indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

e. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.

f. Any party filing a paper containing personal information shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that the personal information cannot be read.

3. Any party filing testimony shall in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, and shall file with the Commission an

original and an electronic version. The original should be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed.

4. Any motion to intervene filed after the date in the procedural schedule attached to this Order shall show a basis for intervention and good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

5. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
