## COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO EACH OF EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.'S MEMBER COOPERATIVES AND BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION'S MEMBER COOPERATIVES

The above-noted utilities, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested herein is due on January 18. 2021. The Commission directs the above-noted utilities<sup>1</sup> to the Commission's March 16, 2020 and March 24, 2020 Orders in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>2</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. The Commission expects the original documents to be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. All responses in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and

indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked. <u>Provide all data in Excel</u> <u>spreadsheet format with all formulas unprotected and all rows and columns fully</u> <u>accessible.</u>

Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

The above-noted utilities shall make timely amendment to any prior response if they obtain information that indicates the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which the above-noted utilities fail or refuse to furnish all or part of the requested information, they shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for their failure to completely and precisely respond. Given the nature of the questions and their timing, the Commission understands each utility may not be able to access the information requested herein.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be

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separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, the above-noted utilities shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.
