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<u>O R D E R</u>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 19, 2020, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) for the six months that ended on April 30, 2020. As part of this review, KU responded to two requests for information.

A review of KU's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$.02069 per kWh in November 2019 to a high of \$0.02342 per kWh in December 2019 with a six-month average of \$0.02202 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of KU's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by KU through its FAC from November 1, 2019, through April 30, 2020, are approved.

2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
