ORDER

On September 2, 2020, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District (Western Lewis-Rectorville District) filed its proposed Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate to be effective October 1, 2020. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's previous GCR rate was approved in Case No. 2020-00172.¹

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's report includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
2. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's report sets out an Expected Gas Cost (EGC) of \$3.9436 per Mcf. Due to a spreadsheet rounding error, Western Lewis-Rectorville District erroneously set out an incorrect EGC. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's corrected EGC is \$3.9437 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.9402 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$3.0035 per Mcf.
3. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's report sets out a Refund Adjustment (RA) of (\$1.2500) per Mcf.

4. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's report sets out a current quarter Actual Adjustment (AA) of (\$.2868) per Mcf. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's total AA is (\$.1589) per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.0344 per Mcf from its previous total AA of (\$.1245) per Mcf.

5. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's report sets out no Balance Adjustment.

6. Western Lewis-Rectorville District's corrected GCR rate is \$2.5348 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.9058 per Mcf from the previous GCR rate of \$1.6290 per Mcf.

7. The rates as set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for service rendered by Western Lewis-Rectorville District on and after October 2, 2020. Western Lewis-Rectorville District did not provide the 30 days' notice required for its rate to be effective October 1, 2020.

8. Should Western Lewis-Rectorville District purchase sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period of any future GCR reports, then the supplier, cost, and amount must be documented in its cover letter to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Western Lewis-Rectorville are denied.

2. The rates set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for service rendered on and after October 2, 2020.

3. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Western Lewis-Rectorville District shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.

4. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
