RE: Informal Conference of June 18, 2026

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on June 16, 2026, an informal conference was conducted on June 18, 2026. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss information contained in the monthly packet prepared for the May 2026 Martin County Water District (Martin District) board meeting.

Martin District stated that it expects the Martin County Fiscal Court to appoint a new commissioner to the previous vacancy on the Martin District Board of Commissioners (Board) at its next meeting. Martin District stated that Vernon Robinson had also resigned from the Board since its last Board meeting. Commission Staff requested that Martin District continue to use the Commission's online system to submit those changes to its Board.

Alliance Water Resources (Alliance) further confirmed that it is still searching for a local General Manager. Colby May is still acting as General Manager for Martin District. Alliance briefly discussed the status of current ongoing projects in Martin District, with all residential meters having been replaced, as well as most commercial meters, and an expected completion date of July 2026 for its zone meter replacements. Alliance reported that it had bid the Turkey tank project, and had received one bid that was over the previously budgeted amount by the district.

Alliance also briefly discussed that Martin District is still waiting on disbursement of funding for the projects provided in its Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Alliance did confirm that the amounts budgeted, as presented in the CIP, are the amounts that will specifically be assigned to those projects once funds are received. Alliance confirmed the amount budgeted for outstanding debts will cover all existing amounts for Martin District's 2015 E-bond, truck leases, KIA loan, and arrearage to Alliance.

Alliance further provided information on the number of accounts closed in the last 12 months, number of accounts opened in the last 12 months, number of delinquent accounts per month for the last 12 months, as well as a billing analysis for Martin District. Staff requested that Martin District and Alliance file a copy of this information in the record, in response to this Memorandum.

Commission Staff and Martin District discussed the timing of these monthly informal conferences, which will now be scheduled in the first week of each month, following the filing of Martin District's most recent board meeting packet, in order to have the most recent board information to discuss. The next informal conference will be set for July 6, 2026.

There being no further discussion, the informal conference was then adjourned.
