## Ladies and Gentlemen:

Please consider this letter our total opposition to Kentucky Power Company's proposed rate increases and also their proposed changes for on-peak/off-peak usage. Firstly, they received a rate increase approximately three years ago—why asking for another so soon? Secondly, the timing is totally inappropriate with our state experiencing the economic crisis brought about by the corona virus epidemic—Kentucky's unemployment rate is soaring. Where is their empathy for people's hardships and situations? Will people have to choose between eating or medical services versus paying their electric bill?
