

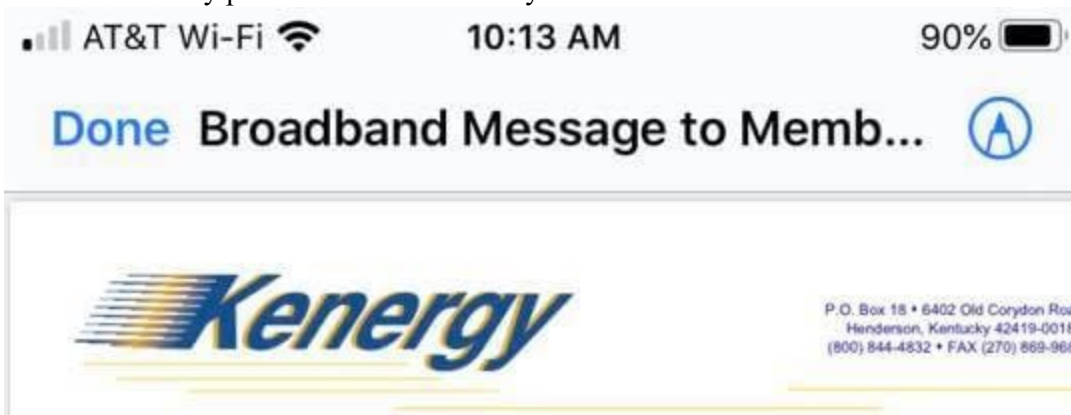

Kenergy, an electric distribution cooperative serving 14 western Kentucky counties is exploring the opportunity to provide broadband services.

"Kenergy is looking into offering broadband services," Kenergy President and CEO Jeff Hohn said. "There are several legislative and regulatory hurdles that we would have to clear before that opportunity would be available for us."

Kenergy's desire to provide broadband access emanates from the same factors that propelled the Rural Electrification Act into existence. For-profit electric utilities had little desire to extend electric service to sparsely populated areas. As a result, Congress passed the Rural Electrification Act in 1936 to provide loans so cooperatives could form and distribute electricity to unserved areas. The nation's broadband providers have followed a similar path. As a result, significant portions of Kenergy's service territory have been left in the dark as to broadband as they were to electricity 80 years ago.

"High-speed broadband can provide substantial value for our communities," said Hohn. "These benefits include greater availability to information, online learning opportunities, economic growth, and increased efficiency for our local businesses."

The cooperative is evaluating financing options and has filed a waiver with the Kentucky Public Service Commission. Kenergy will release more updates and details as they become available.

Greetings,

Thank you for taking the time and opportunity to review the matter of Kenergy providing reliable high-speed internet service to rural Kentucky residents.

Having spent the majority of my life as a resident of rural Hopkins county (Manitou) I can attest that the inability to attain functional internet service has directly hindered my success in many ways.

Firstly, with the strong shift towards online-based learning opportunities, it is nearly impossible to participate. During an online-only public speaking class, I was required to upload 2-5 minute videos of speeches I presented to groups of participants. These video uploads would take longer than 1 hour to upload and often times would require multiple attempts. After doing this for a period, I finally invested in a laptop computer and would drive to McDonald's to use their free public wifi to complete my course. With COVID-19 forcing our youth to attend school from home I can only imagine the frustration and resulting loss of education experienced. Services such as Grammarly (Which I am currently using to ensure this email is as well written as possible) demand a constant connection to the internet to

provide their service.

Secondly, the online marketplace is not only an excellent opportunity for shopping but many times a person can have a small side business online. Imagine, all the extremely talented craftsmen and woman in rural Kentucky being able to present their work to the world and possibly bring additional funds into a community which often is below the poverty line. Not only that, but online content creators, such as YouTube, Instagram, ETC, have at times been able to become incredibly successful by showcasing their talents and entertaining the world through creative, education, or simply fun to watch videos and stories. The multitudes of opportunities to work from home are endless, from Amazon even to many IT jobs have shifted to remote work. An additional benefit of having residents working from home is the value and flexibility it brings to their home life.

Thirdly, the entertainment value of online services. I recently was fortunate enough at my home outside of rural Kentucky to upgrade to FiberOptic internet and realize speeds of 1gigabyte. I am able to fully enjoy on-demand content; such as Netflix, Hulu, Pandora, Amazon Video/Music. Not to mention, the number of times I have personally been able to use Youtube to self teach how to perform a task such as home repair, car maintenance, or educational experience for my children.

In closing, I can say that for greater than 15 years I have routinely contacted AT&T, Mediacom, and anyone who offers true high-speed reliable internet service. Each time I have been told it will not happen, the infrastructure is not available and the demand is too low due. If Kenergy is willing to step to the plate and do for Kentucky what no one else has, all I have to say is "Here's my money, what can I do to help." It's time that rural Kentucky has the basic fundamental utilities available like the rest of the Modern world so that we can live our best lives, have the best opportunities for our Children and Ourselves and most of all be able to have an education we deserve from a University we choose.

Please make it happen for Kentucky!
