I work out of my home and have been battling the poor internet for years. My neighbors and I were so excited when it was announced that fiber optic cable was coming throughout Kentucky 4-5 yrs ago with our county being the last to get it in 2020. Regardless to say, we were all annoyed to find out the project was delayed years. Then I recently called Wade White's office a month ago on this matter and was totally dismayed to found out it wasn't even going to happen.

We love living in Eddyville and on the lake but the internet is the number one downfall. We moved here from Chicagoland so we were a bit spoiled with the internet speed and choices. Again, I have been working out of my home for years and the internet is the integral part of my business. In this day and age of technology, and especially now with every one working
