MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING HELD AT RUSSELL COUNTY COURTHOUSE ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2021 AT 5:00 P.M.

A public meeting was held at the Russell County Courthouse in Jamestown, Kentucky on September 15, 2021 for Mt. Olive Creek Solar's (Mt. Olive Creek) application for a rate increase in Case No. 2020-00226. Karen Wilson, Director of Communications for the Public Service Commission, conducted the information session. She introduced the Commission and explained the procedure and protocol for the information session and the public meeting. Ms. Wilson then offered an overview of the legal basis, criteria and review process for the Commission's consideration of application for proposed rate increase. The presentation included a general overview of Mr. Olive Creek's application by Staff Attorney Jennifer Fell and concluded with a question-andanswer session. Attendees were also told how to submit a public comment in writing if they wished to do so in addition to or in lieu of a comment at the public meeting.

At the conclusion of the information session and after a short intermission, Chairman Kent Chandler, along with Vice Chairman Amy Cubbage, initiated the public meeting portion of the event, setting forth the procedure and protocol for the taking of comments. Chairman Kent Chandler recognized representatives of Mt. Olive Creek and Commission Staff that would be available to meet informally at the end of the meeting. Chairman Kent Chandler then invited the public to make comments to the Commission regarding Mt. Olive Creek's application. The following individuals spoke at the public meeting:

1. Glen Shepherd: Mr. Shepherd lives in Russell Springs, Kentucky. Mr. Shepherd stated that he had spoken with a representative from Mt. Olive Creek regarding his concern of the valuation of his property, and made no further comment.

2. Cameron Tiller: Mr. Tiller lives in Russell Springs, Kentucky. Mr. Tiller is concerned over the effect of property values in the community and believes the property values will be negatively impacted by the project. He believes the local tourism and agriculture will be negatively impacted and is also concerned with the visual impacts from the project and the amount of time the vegetative buffering will take to mature. Mr. Tiller stated the Industrial Revenue Bonds and PILOT payments reached for this project are not significant over the life of the project and is concerned about the project economically benefitting the community as a whole. Mr. Tiller is also concerned regarding the proposed construction schedule of 7 days a week and the noise produced from the construction activities, and asked those activities be limited to exclude weekends. Mr. Tiller was also concerned over the project potentially disturbing historical sites, including possible prehistoric burial grounds.

After all those who indicated a desire to speak on the sign-in sheet were called, others were given the opportunity to speak. Chairman Chandler indicated that the Commission could not take questions but invited the public to question the Commission

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staff in attendance as well as representatives from Mt. Olive Creek after the public meeting adjourned. The public meeting was then adjourned. All persons in attendance at the public meeting were asked, but not required, to sign in and provide their home address for the record. The sign-in sheet is attached hereto.
