KY Public Service Commission,

I am writing to request additional public meeting(s) for the proposed development of an industrial scale solar plant case #2020-00226, in the Mt. Olive Creek area of Russell County, Kentucky. I am a resident of Russell County, Kentucky and have not been adequately informed regarding this proposed project.

I reside near the proposed site and had not heard of its development until April 2021 after a Russell County Fiscal Court Meeting when Industrial Revenue Bonds (IRB's) were approved for its development. After speaking with residents in the community following the April 2021 Fiscal Court meeting, it appears many others were not aware of this project. Some of our locally elected officials have been unable to answer the community's fundamental questions as it relates to this development. Therefore, additional steps must be taken by our local government or the company to answer questions and/or provide more information.

Additionally, I feel that virtually held public meetings via Zoom or online are insufficient given the number of residents in our county that lack high-speed internet services. Like me, many residents are unfamiliar with technology-related services such as Zoom and their functions. I am requesting an in person public meeting be held at a physical location large enough for any citizen in the county who may have questions or concerns and can accommodate those who may require handicap amenities. This location should be inside Russell County and well announced beforehand to help alleviate any scheduling conflicts.
