Bluegrass Water request for sewer rate increase

Dear Sir:

On October 4, 2020 customers of Airview Estates received notice of a proposed sewer rate increase. Enclosed is a petition from Airview Estates Subdivision in which residents have collected signatures protesting the exorbitant proposed increase. There are 128 + households represented by the signatures on the petition, and there is still a petition circulating. (This is quite a large number when you consider how difficult it is these days to find people at home at any given time.) Many of the residents have written letters to your office.

On Oct. 3, 2020 I also wrote to your office. Perhaps I did not state properly that we wish to make a motion to intervene. If my prior letter did not make that clear, please consider this letter as a request for intervention.

Bluegrass Water has filed an application with the Public Service Commission proposing to increase its monthly sewer rate from \$41.30 to \$96.14, an increase of 132.4%, Bluegrass Water believes it could justify a rate increase of 132.4% based upon its operating costs. but has requested the much tower increase to reduce the burden upon its customers. Bluegrass Water is also proposing to begin charging a surcharge of \$1.19 per month for 36 months to pay for sewer tine repairs and replacements mandated by the Kentucky Division of Water- The proposed effective date of the change is <u>October 31, 2020.</u>

Upon request from an intervenors, the utility shall furnish to the intervenor a copy of the application and supporting documents.

Bluegrass Water.

We, the undersigned residents of Airview Estates Subdivision, want to voice our opinion that the proposed increase submitted by Bluegrass Water, is excessive. Between the monthly increase of \$41.36 and the requested increase of \$54.78 they are requesting an increase of approximately132.4%. We are all aware the price of goods and supplies has increased, but this request is ludicrous. LG&E requested and was granted an increase in January 2010 of 12.1%. LWC's proposed increase in their 2010 budget meeting was 4.5 to 5.5%. MSD had a rate increase this year of 6.5%.

WAVE 3 asked Brian Bingham, Regulatory Services Director with MSD, just what the holdup is. "It has always been a priority but there haven't been any active negotiations in recent times, 'I Bingham said. Bingham added that there have been ongoing negotiations to buy out the plant, but they have always broken down over its price tag. "They are a for-profit company and I would assume they do make a profit on it," says Bingham.

A reasonable rate increase may be necessary. This request is beyond the realm of reason. If the owners of this for-profit company cannot efficiently run the company at the current rates or a reasonable increase, they should finally sell it.
