We feel this rate increase should be denied We are now seeing a request up to \$96.14. An increase of 72.1%. We could easily be absorbed into the Frankfort Sewer System and pay much less. The Franklin county road department took over maintenance of our roads

This is an exorbitant rate increase and we feel what we currently pay is appropriate
