PSC Commissioners,

My name is Patrick Ferrell and my address is 240 Sycamore Road, Apartment 4, Lexington KY 40502. I am in KU electric service territory.

I would like to leave a public comment urging the commission to reject KU's proposed net metering tariff. This dramatic reduction in compensating rooftop solar is unreasonable and fails to consider the massive value distributed solar provides in environmental and social benefits, delay/reduction in future distribution and transmission upgrades, and potential savings when our grid undergoes the transition to renewable energy.

The case does not have to be a choice between full retail net metering and the avoided cost rate. Proposing the value of solar at 8-9 cents / kwh and allowing a Feed In Tariff is also a justified option that has been implemented in other parts of the country and abroad.

Rather than just accepting KU's modeling and "expert" opinion, please take the care and effort to challenge the assumptions of their models and projections. Your decision will affect the number of jobs created, the cleanliness of our air, the power that comes from distributed

stakeholders, and our ability to face the climate crisis.
