Subj: LG&E PIPELINE/RATES REQUEST

I am a long time resident of Hillview located in Bullitt County, Ky and located less than a 1/4 mile from the Jefferson County line. Many people believe that we live in Jefferson County because our zip code is listed as 40229 but in reality we are located in Bullitt County. On Wednesday November 18, 2020 the Pioneer News had reported that LG&E and KU which are both owned by PPL have requested a rate increase for electric and natural gas. I strongly request that your commission deny them this rate increase. Reason behind this because they are denying homeowners and businesses natural gas. I have included a letter dated May 10, 2020 stating they have to run an extension for natural gas. Then I had received another letter dated October 23, 2020 stating that they have denied 165 homes/businesses natural gas. There have been 2 different restaurants that stated they would love to build in our area but without natural gas they won't build. Bullitt County currently has 3 different subdivisions planned but again without natural gas they will be forced to use propane vs natural gas. At this time we have a 4 story hotel being built that was denied natural gas so they plan on using propane. I have also enclosed a partial picture of the proposed rate increase. The application is dated for Nov.

I am also requesting that the denial for a natural gas pipeline along KY 245 and through Bernheim Forest along with several private citizens also be denied. They have stated that no resident nor business would be able to utilize this. We also understand that 1 business maybe able to utilize this line in which should also be denied to be attached to the line. The AI No: 120218, County: Bullitt County. It would be more beneficial to the growth of the county if we were able to have new homes/businesses to be able to have access to natural gas. LG&E has the resources to provide the area the gas needed but keep denying Bullitt County. We would appreciate it if you would help our county forcing LG&E to let these new businesses hookup.

We received your facsimile dated October 20, 2020 requesting records regarding deferrals of gas service in Bullitt County. Please note that Louisville Gas and Electric ("LG&E") is not a state entity and is therefore not subject to the Kentucky Open Records Act. Also, LG&E does not publicly disclose customer-specific information.

LG&E can confirm that it has deferred about 165 service requests for new or expanded gas service in Bullitt County due to capacity constraints, and these service requests include individual requests, developments, restaurants, and other businesses.

If you plan on making a request for gas service in Bullitt County, we will be glad to refer you to the appropriate department, and they can explain the process for submitting the request.
