Dear Mr. Schmitt,

I respectfully request the Kentucky Public Service Commission reject Louisville Gas & Electric's application to increase service rates on 1/1/2021. A rate increase of 21.2 % for combined gas and electric customers will create a significant financial burden for many Louisville residents who depend on these services.

During this unprecedented time, we are all being called on to tighten our belts and adjust our budgets. This practice should apply to corporations as well, including public utility providers. Capital projects and improvements to technology are not urgent or time sensitive matters. I am confident the timetables of these projects can be postponed to a later date and achieved through less significant means.

Should the Commission decide a rate increase is warranted, I request that the amount approved be significantly less that the requested amount and less than double digits for the combined services.
