We have had Net Metering for two years. It is an extremely valuable asset. Without Net Metering we could not have afforded solar. We paid the full expense of the initial installation and we also cover the continuing maintenance of the system. If anything goes wrong we cover the cost. Every spring and fall we physically clean the panels. Eventually, say in twenty-five years or so, we must bear the cost of panel replacement. Meanwhile we pay the extra cost in homeowners insurance to protect our investment. Because we generate more energy than needed on sunny days, we depend on Net Metering to meet our demand on cloudy days, and each evening when the sun goes down. Because we cover all the expense related to the solar system we depend on Net Metering to make our investment affordable. We pay LG&E \$15 per month to help cover their maintenance costs, but we have maintenance costs as well. Please keep Net Metering.
