OPENING ORDER

Schroeder Construction Incorporated (Schroeder Construction) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act).<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, *et seq.* Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act

results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as an Appendix. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Schroeder Construction for violation of the following provision of the Act:

KRS 367.4911(1)(a) – Each excavator, or person responsible for an excavation, planning excavation or demolition work shall, not less than two (2) full working days nor more than ten (10) full working days prior to commencing work, notify each affected operator of the excavator's intended work and work schedule. Contacting the applicable protection notification centers shall satisfy this requirement.

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Schroeder Construction violated the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation into the excavation damage incident should be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Schroeder Construction shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to [PSCED@ky.gov](mailto:PSCED@ky.gov) with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.

2. **Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in**


**Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.**

3. The Staff Incident Report 31996 in the Appendix to this Order is made a part of the record in this case.

4. **Please note that notice of a hearing to be held in this matter will be mailed to Schroeder Construction once proof of service is received by the Commission. Parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.**

## INVESTIGATION

*Note:* A review of LT...1196 reveled that on 06/20/19 Schroeder Construction obtained the LT to install a water line, the LT expired on 07/10/19, the damage occurred on 08/21/19, indicating the LT expired 42 days before the Incident Date. (See Attachment 1 and LT Summary above)

On 05/04/20 the Operator, LG&E's Mike Jones provided a Dig Tix Facts-Based Investigation with photographs indicting Schroeder Construction caused the damage.

**Dig Tix Facts-Based Investigation w/Photographs are include as Attachment 3.**

On 05/06/20 Mr. Jones provided a LG&E Field Investigative Report.

- **LG&E Field Investigative Report:** Indicates that Schroeder Construction caused the damage, they were still on site, Jacob Schroeder was in charge and Schroeder Construction returned to the job to repair a water leak. The report indicates that LT 1906191318 was obtained, the facilities were not marked, the Excavator agreed the facilities were not marked, the flags were outside the dig area, the LT was expired and no new LT was submitted.

**LG&E Field Investigative Report is include as Attachment 4.**

*Note:* A review of LT...1318 reveled that on 06/19/19 Schroeder Construction obtained the LT to install a water line, the LT expired on 07/09/19, the damage occurred on 08/21/19, indicating the LT expired 43 days before the Incident Date. (See Attachment 1 and LT Summary above)

On 05/08/20 Mr. Jones provide photographs and invoice.

- 15 Photographs: Depicting the damage and vehicles at the incident location all with LG&E logos.
- Invoice: Indicating Schroeder Construction was billed \$651.13 for the damage and Mr. Jones stated Schroeder Construction paid for the damages in September 2019 but provided no receipt of payment.

On 05/15/20 Mr. Schroder stated, via email ([scijacob@gmail.com](mailto:scijacob@gmail.com)), that he was unable to find photographs of this incident. Mr. Schroder stated that he recalls the line was marked, it was broken one time prior and when it was repaired it veered off center approximately two feet. Mr. Schroder stated that they were digging off the marks resulting in the damage. Mr. Schroder was informed without a valid LT a Demand Letter will be sent assessing a penalty of \$2,000.00 and as of today's date Mr. Schroder has provided no valid LT.

On 05/20/20 Mr. Jones provided a copy of a check from Schroder Construction to LG&E indicating Schroder Construction paid for the damage.


