ORDER

On August 13, 2021, Sebree Solar, LLC (Sebree Solar), filed an application seeking a Construction Certificate to construct an approximately 250-megawatt merchant electric solar facility and an approximately 4.5-mile nonregulated electric transmission line located in Henderson and Webster counties, Kentucky. Having reviewed the application, the Siting Board finds that a procedural schedule should be established to ensure for the orderly processing of this proceeding. The Siting Board further finds, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 6, that a public hearing should be scheduled in order to extend the statutory deadline from 120 days to 180 days for the processing of this matter.

The Siting Board further finds that Sebree Solar is required to give notice of the hearing in compliance with 807 KAR 5:110, Section 9(1), that requires that at least three days before the hearing date, the applicant shall submit to the Siting Board proof that it has given notice of the hearing to each party and to the general public by publication in a

newspaper of general circulation in the county or municipality in which the solar generating facility is proposed to be located. In addition, the notice of hearing shall include the following statements: “This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov”; and “Public comments may be made at the beginning of the hearing. Those wishing to make oral public comments may do so by following the instructions listed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov.” At the time the notice is mailed or publication is requested, Sebree Solar shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed for this proceeding.

2. Sebree Solar shall give notice of the hearing in compliance with 807 KAR 5:110, Section 9(1). In addition, the notice of hearing shall include the following statements: “This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov”; and “Public comments may be made at the beginning of the hearing. Those wishing to make oral public comments may do so by following the instructions listed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov.” At the time the notice is mailed or publication is requested, Sebree Solar shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.
