<u>ORDER</u>


The Commission, on its own motion, initiated this proceeding on May 13, 2021, for the purpose of requiring Jonathan Creek Water District (Jonathan Creek District) to file for an adjustment in base rates or file for an alternative rate filing within one year of the date of that Order to ensure that its rates are sufficient to maintain reasonable water service for its customers. On May 13, 2022, Jonathan Creek District filed an application requesting to adjust its monthly water service rates in compliance with the May 13, 2021 Order.¹ The Commission's concern raised in this proceeding that Jonathan Creek District may be relying upon its depreciation expense to continue to provide reasonable service will be addressed in Case No. 2021-00410. Therefore, the Commission finds that this case should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
