SITING BOARD STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO BLUEBIRD SOLAR LLC

Bluebird Solar LLC (Bluebird Solar), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 16, 2022. The Siting Board directs Bluebird Solar to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Bluebird Solar shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Bluebird Solar obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Bluebird Solar fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Bluebird Solar shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filling a paper containing personal information, Bluebird Solar shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide any power purchase agreements that have been completed for the project. Include any information regarding additional power purchase agreements for the remaining megawatts (MW) of generation.

- 2. Provide details on the sound mitigation plan Bluebird Solar will utilize during construction since there was an objection to sound blanketing/shrouding as recommended by Wells Engineering.
- 3. Provide the Interconnection Service Agreement Bluebird Solar has entered into with PJM Interconnection, LLC.
 - 4. Provide the Phase 1 Environmental Assessment.
- 5. Provide any easement or crossing agreements that have been, or are in the process of being, negotiated to connect the project sections.
