COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO CAWOOD WATER DISTRICT

Cawood Water District (Cawood District), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on June 2, 2026. The Commission directs Cawood District to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Cawood District shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Cawood District obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Cawood District fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Cawood District shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Cawood District shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to the March 30, 2026 letter from Cawood District, requesting to use water loss surcharge funds to replace meters within the system that are no longer reading and causing water loss.

- a. Explain whether the referenced failing meters are residential meters and provide details regarding the make, model and estimated remaining life of the meters that need replacement.

b. Provide the number of meters that Cawood District has identified as failing and need replacement.

c. Provide details regarding the make, model, and cost, for the proposed replacement meters.

d. Provide a copy of any estimate(s) Cawood District has received for the cost of the proposed replacement meters.

e. Confirm whether Cawood District would use an outside contractor or would perform installation of the replacement meters with its own personnel, and provide an estimate of the cost of labor for installation of the replacement meters.

f. Provide an explanation of how Cawood District would prioritize the projects previously approved in its Qualified Infrastructure Improvement Plan, and the proposed meter replacements, if they are approved by the Commission.
