ORDER

On May 10, 2021, Dexter-Almo Heights Water District (Dexter-Almo District) filed with the Commission, through counsel, revisions to its rules and regulations to be effective June 1, 2021. The revisions proposed were as follows: (1) added a requirement that prospective customers provide a government-issued photo ID before service is supplied by Dexter-Almo District; (2) added an option for customers to pay their bills by ACH; (3) minor text changes to the late payment penalty provision and the customer general information sheet; (4) revised the customer account card; and (5) added a partial payment form and right-of-way easement form to the tariff. Dexter-Almo District requested that the 30-day statutory notice period set forth in KRS 278.180(1) be shortened to expedite Commission review of the revisions so that customers would have the option of paying their bills by ACH beginning on June 1, 2021. On May 13, 2021, Dexter-Almo District filed a letter withdrawing the requirement that prospective customers provide a government-issued photo ID before service is supplied by Dexter-Almo District. That letter is attached to this Order as an Attachment.

KRS 278.030 provides that a utility may collect fair, just and reasonable rates and that the service it provides must be adequate, efficient and reasonable. Having considered the proposed tariff revisions as modified by Dexter-Almo District's May 13,

2021 letter and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the tariff revisions are reasonable and should be approved. In order to allow customers to pay their bills by ACH starting on June 1, 2021, the Commission finds good cause to reduce the notice period pursuant to KRS 278.180(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Dexter-Almo District's request to shorten the notice period under KRS 278.180(1) is approved.

2. Dexter-Almo District's proposed revisions to its tariff, as modified by its May 13, 2021 letter, are approved for service rendered on and after June 1, 2021.

3. Within 20 days of the date of the entry of this Order, Dexter-Almo District shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the revisions approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.

4. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
