RE: Informal Conference of March 6, 2025

Pursuant to an Order issued on March 3, 2024, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on March 6, 2024. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the motion to re-open this matter, which stated, in part, that Kentucky Power sought to

convene an informal conference for the purpose of discussing Kentucky Power's decision to seek the necessary regulatory approvals to make the capital investments required to continue taking capacity and energy from the Mitchell Plant after December 31, 2028, and to request an expedited procedural schedule to facilitate the Commission's review and approval of the Company's proposals related to the same.

During the IC Tanner Wolfram and other representatives from Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) stated that Kentucky Power will file a new application containing several requests related to the Mitchell Generation Station (Mitchell Station) including, but not necessarily limited to, the continued taking of capacity and energy from Mitchell Station after December 31, 2028; the recovery of any such investments; as well as Kentucky Power's share of any effluent limitations guidelines (ELG) made by Wheeling Power to Mitchell Station to date; and the recovery of that amount.

Kentucky Power did not believe that West Virginia's Public Service Commission's approval would be needed for any of the requested changes related to Mitchell Station and referenced the lack of action by the West Virginia Commission when the Virginia Commission took similar action as to what Kentucky Power will request in this new filing.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
