We believe the hearing yesterday made this case clear and easy for this commission board to DENY this construction application from Russellville Solar. The presentation from Russellville Solar, their attorney, and their witnesses all make the case to DENY this project. They showed no need for this project, no construction plan to construct this project, no ability to plan this project, no maintenance of this facility, and no benefit financially or any other benefit to Logan County or Kentucky.

We hope the witnesses were either misinformed or misled in much of their testimony with statements such as the Pembroke topsoil will be stripped from the farmland but no harm will come to the Pembroke farmland. Really.

We greatly thank you for asking about the ability of the Vick Family Trust to access our property and hope you will share your requested map of this easement with the Trust.

That being said, with the lack of evidence from Russellville Solar yesterday and all the other global impending factors surrounding this 1500 acre property we respectfully request that you Mister Chairman and the PSC Sitting Board DENY this proposed construction application. We truly believe that the board has no valid reason at all to approve this construction application.
