ORDER

The Commission, on its own motion, hereby continues the hearing in this matter set for June 18, 2024, to a date to be determined later. As grounds for this Order, the Commission states that on May 23, 2024, Andy Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, signed Executive Order 2024-355 declaring June 19, 2024, a state holiday. The Commission anticipates this hearing will take more than one day. As a result of the hearing being continued, Kentucky Power’s motion requesting permission to have a stenographer is now moot.¹

The Commission reminds Kentucky Power of its continued obligation to provide adequate, efficient, and reasonable service to the utility’s customers.² Nothing in this Order should be construed as prohibiting further Orders in this matter nor should any party interpret this Order to indicate the Commission is not diligently pursuing this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The hearing set for June 18, 2024, is continued to a date to be determined later.


