MINUTES OF THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING HELD AT ROUGH RIVER STATE PARK ON MARCH 3, 2022 AT 5:00 P.M.

A public hearing was held at Rough River State Park on March 3, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of taking public comment regarding the Joint Applicants' application to construct a wireless telecommunications facility to be located at 2589 Blue Bird Road, Falls of Rough, Kentucky, 40119. Amy Cubbage, Vice Chairman, Public Service Commission, initiated the local public hearing, setting forth the procedure and protocol for taking comments, introduced the representative from AT&T and Commission Staff, stating they would be available after the hearing for questions, then invited the public to make comments to the Commission. The following individuals spoke at the public hearing:

1. Roger Nicolai: Mr. Nicolai is the owner of the neighboring property. His family is solely dependent on cell service. He agrees a need exists for the tower. However, the tower will be within 500 ft. of his house. According to Mr. Nicolai, the tower will affect property value, 10% depreciation confirmed by multiple studies. He stated that he had contacted the author of one of the studies who stated it would likely affect the

property value. According to him, towers affect value within 2300 feet of visibility of the structure. There is no way to offset the loss of value on his property from the tower lease income like the Newtons. He is not opposed to a cell tower being built on the Newton's property; he just does not want it at is proposed location.

- 2. Janelle Nicolai: Ms. Nicolai also lives on neighboring farm. She sites to same study as husband. She stated that tower will be visible from the entirety of the back of their house. According to Ms. Nicolai, the Newtons have comparable locations on their farm to move it. She said that the residents who requested hearing didn't have financial gain by doing so.
- 3. Emily Parks: Ms. Parks lives in the Falls of Rough area. She stated she was there to support the Nicolais. She said that they are a homestead community. According to Ms. Parks, the tower is taking away from the Nicolais' kids futures.
- 4. Kimberly Newton: Ms. Newton owns the farm leased for the cell tower with her husband. According to Ms. Newton, the hill on the property was considered but it had too steep of a grade to make easily accessible. The tower will be in a location that is visible to see children in the area should they go to play around it.
- 5. James Spencer: Mr. Spencer lives in the Falls of Rough area. He has serious health concerns. He stated that he can't get a signal sometimes when he needs it. He just wants good cell service.
- 6. Hugh Coppage: Mr. Coppage lives across the way from the Newtons' farm. He stated that he and his wife might get half a bar of cell service and calls drop often. According to him, they need the tower. Mr. Coppage stated that he felt like it wouldn't depreciate the value of the neighbors' farm but didn't know for sure.

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- 7. Tiffany Sweeney: Ms. Sweeney did not live by the proposed cell tower but was instead there in support of the Nicolais. She stated that they are building a community in this area and the Nicolai farm is part of that effort. Ms. Sweeney said it is important to listen to everyone in order to get what all the parties need out of a situation.
- 8. Martha Coppage: Ms. Coppage resides across the way from the Newtons' farm. She said they have no cell phone service, and they need it.
- 9. Terry Newton: Mr. Newton owns the land that has been leased to construct the new cell phone tower. According to Mr. Newton, the tower will increase Nicolais' ability to do business by improving cell service. He stated that they considered other locations; some areas were too wooded and there were easements on the farm as well. He believes that the community needs the tower. He claimed that the tower was more like 800-900 feet from the Nicolais' house. He mentioned there was an easement that prevents the tower from being further away in the same line and a row of trees exists as a boundary. Mr. Newton stated the studies sited by the Nicolais are city and suburb studies, and no rural studies have been done on the effect of a tower on property value.
- 10. Eric Higdon: Mr. Higdon resides in Indiana but owns property in the Falls of Rough area. He is a retired police officer. He said that there is no cell service and it's a public safety issue. The delay that poor cell service could cause in an emergency is very concerning for him especially as it relates to Mr. Spencer's health. According to Mr. Higdon, it already takes first responders a bit of time to get to a location and a delay could be awful.
- 11. Vickie Catlin: Ms. Catlin resides in the Falls of Rough area. She is employed as a school bus driver as are several of her friends. According to Ms. Catlin, they do not

always get the school cancellation notifications. The lack of service also makes it difficult to communicate with parents of children on her route. Ms. Catlin said that Verizon has good service but not AT&T in the area. She wants to find an answer that makes everyone happy.

After all those who indicated a desire to speak on the sign-in sheet were called, others were given the opportunity to speak. Several additional comments were made by:

- 1. Tiffany Sweeney: In rebuttal comments, Ms. Sweeney mentioned that it will be difficult for any agro-tourism to occur if the tower was in the Nicolais' backyard.
- 2. Terry Newton: Mr. Newton stated that this was a public safety issue. He also said that he was willing to show the Nicolais where the footprint of the tower would fall on his property. He reiterated that the community needed the tower, and it would help businesses.

Vice Chairman Cubbage indicated that the Commission could not take questions but invited the public to question Commission Staff in attendance as well as the representative from AT&T after the local public hearing adjourned. The local public hearing adjourned. All persons in attendance at the public meeting were asked, but not required, to sign in and provide their home address for the record. The sign-in sheet is attached hereto.
