RE: Informal Conference of August 28, 2023

Pursuant to an Order issued on August 24, 2023, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on August 28, 2023. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss alternative site locations for the cellular facilities.

The Applicants have begun to explore alternatives but wanted to get feedback on where the Intervenors might not find objectionable. Mr. Brown asked about whether the concern and measurement was from the center of the tower or the edge of the compound.

The Nicolais stated that that their concern is the measurement from the compound. They mentioned that 800-850 ft. might be acceptable. They emphasized a desire for a lack of visibility although the lay of the land, involving a hill, might make that difficult.

The parties discussed coverage around the compound, including what might be an acceptable treeline. The Nicolais did say that they did want not want the Newtons to lose the lease opportunity.

The parties also discussed the removal of the old home. The home was buried and the Nicolais discussed concerns about how that would affect building in that area. Mr. Brown mentioned the evidence in the record regarding the minimal risk of tower collapse and the applicants adherence to acceptable building standards to prevent issues.

The Nicolais mentioned that they preferred their proposed alternatives. Mr. Brown stated that he would discuss it with his client.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
