ORDER

By Commission Order issued December 4, 2024, a hearing was previously set in this matter for February 20, 2025, and February 21, 2025. On January 6, 2025, East Kentucky Midstream, LLC (East Kentucky Midstream) filed a motion to reschedule the hearing. East Kentucky Midstream stated that one attorney representing East Kentucky Midstream was unavailable on these dates.¹ In addition, East Kentucky Midstream stated the week of March 24, 2025 would work for the hearing for counsel of the parties.²

Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that East Kentucky Midstream's motion to reschedule the hearing is granted, in part, and denied, in part. The Commission finds good cause to cancel the hearing in this matter based on the unavailability of one attorney for East Kentucky Midstream. However, the proposed week of March 24, 2025, is not available. The Commission believes that an informal conference (IC) will be beneficial to discussing potential issues that the parties may resolve in advance of a hearing in the matter. As such, the Commission finds that an IC should be

held on February 21, 2025, at 9 a.m. Eastern Standard Time. The IC may be virtual and Commission Staff should ensure parties are provided a link, if needed.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. East Kentucky Midstream's motion is granted, in part, and denied, in part.
2. The hearing previously scheduled in this matter for February 20, 2025, and February 21, 2025, is canceled. A separate order will be issued scheduling the new hearing date.
3. An in-person, with virtual option, IC shall be held on February 21, 2025, at 9 a.m. Eastern Standard Time.
4. Commission Staff should coordinate with parties to ensure all virtual participants have a link.
5. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as prohibiting further orders in this matter.
