## ORDER

On February 9, 2024,<sup>1</sup> Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) filed a letter requesting that the Commission make a rehearing decision on the existing evidentiary record. The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Office of Rate intervention (Attorney General) also filed a recommendation for the Commission to make a decision on the record.<sup>2</sup> However, the Attorney General requested to have the opportunity to file a brief to address the issues presented in Duke Kentucky's petition for rehearing.<sup>3</sup> The Kroger Company,<sup>4</sup> Walmart Inc.,<sup>5</sup> and Kentucky

Broadband and Cable Association<sup>6</sup> (KBCA) each filed statements requesting that the Commission make a decision on the evidentiary record.<sup>7</sup>

Having considered the requests, the Commission finds that the Attorney General's request to file briefs should be granted. The Commission finds that a hearing is not necessary to decide the rehearing issues and will make a decision based on the evidentiary record before it.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The Attorney General's request to brief the rehearing issues is granted.
- 2. If a party so chooses, simultaneous briefs shall be due on March 18, 2024.
- 3. If a party so chooses, simultaneous response briefs shall be due on April 1, 2024.
- 4. This matter shall stand submitted as of 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time on April 2, 2024.
