## MINUTES OF THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING HELD AT ELIZABETHTOWN HIGH SCHOOL ON MAY 23, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M.

A public hearing was held at Elizabethtown High School on May 23, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of taking public comment regarding Kentucky Utilities Company's (KU) application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of transmission facilities in Hardin County, Kentucky. Kent Chandler, Chairman, Public Service Commission, initiated the local public hearing, setting forth the procedure and protocol for taking comments, introduced the representative from KU and Commission Staff, stating they would be available after the hearing for questions, then invited the public to make comments to the Commission. The following individuals spoke at the public hearing:

Rose Gravell, 1055 Glendale-Hodgenville Road West. Ms. Gravell is concerned that SK Innovation's role in building the new battery production facilities is unclear, other than SK Innovation is a partner with Ford. Ms. Gravell proposed that other routes for the transmission line be considered to balance the cost to landowners and benefits to KU. Chairman Chandler indicated that the Commission could not take questions but invited the public to question Commission Staff in attendance as well as the representative from KU after the local public hearing adjourned. The local public hearing adjourned. All persons in attendance at the public meeting were asked, but not required, to sign in and provide their home address for the record.
