For each water division long-term debt, the city of Manchester identified, include an explanation as to why the debt was incurred.
- Refer to the schedule for future principal and interest payment at page 23 of the 2020 Independent Auditor's Report. Provide the principal and interest payment schedule for water division's long-term debt identified above for the fiscal years 2023 through 2027.
