Dear Executive Director Bridwell,

This is an application to pass through an increase in certain nonrecurring charges – tap-on fees – for the Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District's Sewer Service Tariff. A corresponding increase in Lexington Fayette Urban County Government's ("LFUCG") tap-on fees brought about the need for the District's proposed increases. These charges will apply to all of the District's future sanitary sewer customers.

Enclosed please find: 1) proposed tariff sheets; 2) LFUCG's notice of increase; 3) notice to customers; 4) an affidavit stating that District staff mailed out the notice to all sewer customers on June 3, 2022; and 5) a letter to the Attorney General evidencing electronic transmission of this filing to that office at that office at that office at <u>rateintervention@Ky.gov</u>. The District has previously filed income statements and balance sheets with the Commission that are currently on file in your office.

My client is not requesting a rate increase at this time, in the context of this application, although a rate study case is currently pending with the PSC (2022-00053). However, increased costs attributable to the subject nonrecurring charges increase cannot be financially absorbed by the District, and, respectfully, the District should not be penalized with absorbing these costs while waiting on the pending rate study case. The additional revenue generated by the proposed nonrecurring charges will not exceed five (5%) percent of the total revenues provided by all nonrecurring charges for the most recent twelve-month period.
