My name is David Paige and I was formerly the Manager of Green River Valley Water District. I retired on [July 26th, 2022](#).

Based upon my conversations with Mike Foley, it was my understanding that Green River Valley Water District had received another extension of time and that it did not have to file a rate case until [September 21, 2022](#).

It is too early to file a rate case because the Water Treatment Plant rehab project is not yet complete. This project has had one delay after another because of supply chain issues and problems with the contractor.

In my opinion, it doesn't make sense to file a rate case until this project is complete and has been in operation for at least two months so we can determine the actual cost of operating it going forward.
